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## Testing of Finished Measurement Tables

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### Objective:

The finished measurements of the product must agree with the stated finished measurements on the packaging and/or the given finished measurement table.

### The test is particularly well-suited for:

- All types of clothing
- Home textiles and bedding
- Finished products (e.g. sleeping bags, automobile seat covers)

### Description:

- Correct grading ensures that for different sizes the relationship between finished measurement and body measurement remains the same.
- Finished measurement tables are an important instrument within quality control for monitoring previously agreed and/or set data.
- Finished measurements and finished measurement tables are as a rule, specific to both product and company. Exceptions: Personal protective clothing (in this case, norms have led to a certain level of standardization).
- In general, binding finished measurement tables are unavailable.

### Customer benefit:

- Comparison between the finished size table and the product
- Prompt recognition of deviations
- Adaptations to the finished measurement tables are possible

Set of sizes in original

#### Duration of testing:

Maximum of 10 working days
