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Fit and Workmanship Tests

Objective:

These tests are used to determine the "fit and professional workmanship" of textiles.

The test is particularly well-suited for:

- all types of clothing
- home textiles and bedding
- finished products (e.g. sleeping bags, automobile seat covers)

Description:

Workmanship requirements:

Workmanship must be carried out in such a way that it does not detract from the fitness for purpose, fit or appearance of the product.

- Testing of the packaging/presentation
- Testing for visible flaws, damage or defects
- Testing of the materials' and care labelling
- Test for precision finishing

Fit requirements:

Requirements for a well-fitting garment:

- Fit testing using human subjects
- Assessment by trained, expert personnel
- Assurance of fit within the scope of product development

Customer benefit:

- Evaluation of the product by an independent institution
- Recognition of defects at the sample stage
- Continual evaluation of product quality
- Comparative evaluation of suppliers
- Discussion of the results with the customer

Requirements for test samples:

General:

Fit test of garment in new condition → Care according to care label →

Fit test after care

and / or test of workmanship of garment in new condition

Amount of material:

Individual items to a complete size set

Duration of testing:

Maximum of 10 working days

Express service: 5 working days
